The advocate also provides Transition Services by presenting the program to nursing facility staff, identifying eligible transition consumers and providing assistance in locating appropriate housing, furnishings and independent living skills training to ensure the consumer's successful transition to living independently in the community.

Wages begin at \$16.80 an hour.
